- *R v Steven Samuel* [2006] - Fraud related murder
- *R v Sion Jenkins* [2005/07] - Billy-Jo murder by step father
- *R v Grant* [2005] 3 WLR 437 - Abuse of process - police monitoring solicitor/client conversations at police stations
- *R v John Russell & McNee* [2005-06] - "The Trusthorpe Murders" the largest motor insurance fraud involving false accident claims, a multi-handed gangland murder, and a £4M drugs importation
- *R v Adelina Muanza* [2005] - Conspiracy to murder, witchcraft child cruelty to children
- *R v Kirubanantharasa Gunaratnam* [2005] - Murder
- *R v Mark Latta* [2004/05] - Baby shaking Murder
- *R v JR* - Murder trial at the Central Criminal Court. Representing a young man alleged to have been involved in a fatal stabbing incident, with over 40 eyewitnesses (JR was the only defendant acquitted)
- *R v Jon Tinker* - Private prosecution for gross negligence and corporate manslaughter: death on Mount Everest expedition
- *R v Syron Martin* (CCC) - Shooting in Tottenham High Road - provocation/Post Traumatic Stress Disorder
- *R v A Juvenile* (CCC) - Murder of a 14 year old by another 14 year old; provocation involving conduct disorder
- *R v Causley* (Exeter CC) - Retrial of notorious 1985 "no body" domestic murder following a CCRC referral to the CA
