**CONSENT ORDER**

**UPON** the Respondent agreeing to withdraw and revise her guidance on fee waiver for entry clearance applications entitled "ECB06: entry clearance fees" with a view to introducing a criterion of affordability in appropriate cases, and in doing so, to have regard to the submissions made by the Applicant in the grounds of Judicial Review,

**AND UPON** the Respondent agreeing to notifying the Applicant as to the revised guidance within 7 days of its publication,

**AND UPON** the Respondent agreeing to withdraw the decision under challenge to refuse the Applicant's applications for fee waiver and reconsider the application in the light of the revised guidance having regard to any further submissions and evidence provided by the Applicant within 28 days of the publication of the revised guidance,

**By consent, it is ordered that:**

1. The Applicant has permission to withdraw this Judicial Review claim.

2. The Respondent shall pay the Applicant's reasonable costs, to be assessed if not agreed.
3. There shall be a detailed assessment of the Applicant's publically funded costs in accordance with the Civil Legal Aid (Costs) Regulations 2013
